All staff are expected to

- Be a good role model.
- Respect the children.
- Respect the parents.
- Communicate in a way that is respectful and courteous.

All parents are expected to

- Be a good role model.
- Show respect for teachers.
- Show respect for other parents whether it be inside the building or outside in the parking lot.
- Be respectful of other children by refraining from posting pictures or videos of other children without the permission from their parents.

If a parent fails to observe this code of conduct after being warned about a breach, the preschool will terminate the enrollment of their child.
